Halloween Update: NEW Parade Time for 1st - 5th grades: 8:45 am on the playground on 10/31

- TK and Kinder won't be participating in the whole school parade.
- Students should come to school in costume on 10/31 if they celebrate Halloween. No weapons or scary masks, costumes must be "school appropriate".
- Students who don't celebrate Halloween or don't wish to participate will be given an alternate activity and location during the parade.
- Students should bring clothes to change into after the parade if they won't be able to participate in recess/PE in their costume.
- Grades 1 5 will line up on the playground in a big circle at 8:45 am. We will
 parade once around in a circle and then go out the gate on MLK on the sidewalk
 to Channing, right on Channing to McKinley, right on McKinley back to the gate.
 By 9:20 am, we will likely be back in classrooms.
- Parents are welcome on campus and are invited to join the parade.
- After the parade, most students will choose to change out of costume, and be ready for PE/recess and to function in the classroom.
- Please don't send candy to school after Halloween.
