ATTENTION 5th grade Families: Information about middle school enrollment will be shared with families of 5th graders in December. All enrollment documents will be due on **February 3rd** (unless you live outside of Berkeley and need to request an inter-district permit).

The process can be a bit challenging, so it's highly recommended that you have all of the required documents ready by January 2nd. The <u>Enrollment Checklist</u> shows which documents need to be submitted online for enrollment of your child to middle school. The online enrollment form should be available in early January.

Families living outside of the City of Berkeley should review the inter-district permit process on the BUSD Admissions website for <u>Inter-district Permits & Transfers</u>. Plan to submit the documents at least 2 weeks ahead of the deadline in case there are glitches or problems that need to be addressed.
