
Q: When does the 2023-24 school year start? A: The school board determines the start date and will let us know when they decide this!

Jewish group at Washington Elementary

Dear parent(s)/guardian(s) of Jewish-identifying students at Washington Elementary, My name is Jessica Pearlman and I am mom to a Washington kindergartener. This is our family's first year at BUSD and I, along with my sister Ilana (also mom to a kindergartener), have been concerned about the lack of visibility/acknowledgment of Jews and Jewish culture within BUSD and Washington specifically. Especially considering the current displays of antisemitism within our broader Berkeley community (distribution of antisemitic flyers on people's doorsteps, vandalism of billboards, etc.) and, frankly, the largely silent response to those acts, we want to bring a bigger Jewish presence and awareness to Washington's campus.

Our vision is to:

- 1) find fellow Jewish-identifying members who would like to form a community within Washington
- 2) create events for us to connect and have fun, perhaps once a month and around Jewish holidays
- 3) bring awareness of Jews and Jewish culture to Washington specifically, and eventually more broadly within BUSD

The **Affordable Connectivity Program** is an FCC benefit program that helps ensure that households can afford the broadband they need for work, school, healthcare and more.

The benefit provides a discount of up to \$30 per month toward internet service for eligible households and up to \$75 per month for households on qualifying Tribal lands. Eligible households can also receive a one-time discount of up to \$100 to purchase a laptop, desktop computer, or tablet from participating providers if they contribute more than \$10 and less than \$50 toward the purchase price.

**One of the ways to be eligible for this program is to be approved to receive free or reduced-price school lunch. If you have not signed up for the free lunch program this year it's not too late.

Two Steps to Enroll

1. Go to AffordableConnectivity.gov to submit an application or print out a

mail-in application.

2. Contact your preferred participating provider to select a plan and have the discount applied to your bill.

Eligible households must both apply for the program and contact a participating provider to select a service plan.
