Mentors at Washington We have 2 mentoring programs at Washington:

BUILD is a reading support program run at all BUSD elementary schools, with guidelines that are set by BUILD. Here are the parameters:

Students must be enrolled in either LEARNS or BEARS (this is so the mentors, who are Cal students, have direct supervision).

BUILD prioritizes students who are socioeconomically disadvantaged, speak English as a second language (without an adult who reads English at home), and/or are below grade-level in reading.

BUILD enrollment is dependent on how many mentors the program has to bring to our site, Right now we have 34 students enrolled, and 20 on our wait list.

Parents can contact the director of the after-school program the child is in (LEARNS or BEARS), or Liz Scarboro (Response To Intervention teacher) if they are interested in BUILD elizabethscarboro@berkeley.net

SAGE mentors work with students one-on-one, once a week in their classrooms, and offer socioemotional support. Parents can reach out to their child's teacher if they are interested in SAGE. Teachers recommend students directly for SAGE, and if there are more recommendations than spots, the Coordination Of Services Team (COST) looks at the overall list to prioritize with the help of teachers and counselors. Right now we have 33 students with SAGE mentors, and 20 on the wait list.
