

Safe Routes to School Program presents: Bike to School Day May 18 Jump on the Bike Train! Bike to School Day is Thursday, May 18, and Washington parents are organizing a morning bike train to promote safe and healthy transportation options for getting to school. We have two meet-up options: one is at Ward and Park (from NE corner of San Pablo Park, riding up Ward to California; led by Scott Friese) and another is at California and Hearst (from the Ohlone Park, riding south on California; led by Ben Gerhardstein). Both groups will depart at 7:40am and converge at California and Channing at 7:50am. After a quick water break, we'll head up Channing at 7:55am and make our way to campus. Riders can join at either of the meet-up points or jump on the train en route!
