

Starting on Monday 3/14, students and staff in BUSD are not required to mask indoors or out. As masking is still strongly recommended, it is expected that many will continue to wear masks, especially inside. Mitigation measures such as increased ventilation, air filtration, eating outside, weekly COVID testing, contact tracing, restricting access to campus and supplying free surgical masks will continue.

Please note that school staff cannot enforce parent preference for their student wearing or not wearing masks. Please have this conversation at home. Kindness, courtesy, and respect for each other will be important as we get used to this new normal.
