**Vaccine Clinic** In partnership with Carbon Health, the City of Berkeley will be hosting a vaccine clinic this Saturday May 14, 2022 from 9:00-4:00 at the Young Adult Project (YAP) located at 1700 Oregon.

This clinic is free to everyone and available by drop-in or appointment. You do not need insurance to get vaccinated. You will not be asked about for a social security number or immigration status.

Anyone 5 years old and above can receive their first or second dose of Pfizer. Anyone 12 years old and above can receive their first or second dose of Pfizer. Those who are eligible can receive boosters as well!

The City is currently offering \$25 gift cards to target to anyone who receives their first or second dose at this clinic.
